Dear MRS. CURTIS:

Here is the information that I have on JOSIAH AUSTIN. He is buried at McKendree Chapel Cemetery in Bond County, Illinois - a cemetery with Chapel established in 1842 by my great-great grand-father, ALEXANDER MYATT. I copied the following information from the stones there last March while visiting in Illinois:

"JOSIAH AUSTIN - June 4, 1799 - August 29, 1883"

"JANE AUSTIN his 1st wf - Dec 12, 1799 - Oct 7, 1876"

"EMILY C. AUSTIN his 2nd wf - Oct 3, 1823 - Oct 23, 1902"

"WILLIAM AUSTIN "about" 1832 - July 31, 1854"

EMILY A. AUSTIN was EMILY C. MYATT born in Dickson Co., Tenn., dau of ALEXANDER MYATT (Feb 9, 1802 - Sep 4, 1865) and 1MARY [Mary] CHISENHALL (1802 - 1833). EMILY'S first husband was DOCTOR F. COLE, who died Aug 29 1852. They had six children. Of course, she was elderly, and JOSIAH wasn't ancient when they were (continued)

married; so none of JOSIAH'S children were hers.
