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Page 372 - AUSTIN Family - JOSEPH AUSTIN, who owned part of the mill property at Cochecho Falls, in 1649 and later resided at Dover Neck, having come there probably from Hampton where a JOSEPH AUSTIN resided in 1642. He moved up to Cochecho at an early day, though where his house was, we have no means of knowing. In addition, he had various grants from the town, one as follows:

A grant of 100 acres, laid out "between Quamphegon & Gaynt Albens Cove, partly or together by Nechoaneck River, on ye South East and on the North East by HENERY TIBBETS hundred acres of land and partly by THOMAS HANDSON'S hundred; on South West side by a heyway that is to lay between THOS CANEY & him "also a grant of 50 acres at Fresh Creek etc."

JOSEPH AUSTIN marr (probably as his 2nd wife) SARAH, dau of Elder STARBUCK and widow of WILLIAM TOREY. Her first husband died ca 1658. She marr a 3rd husband after AUSTIN'S death viz HUMPHREY VARNEY. MR. AUSTIN made his will June 6, 1662 and it was proved July 1, 1663.

There was a SAMUEL AUSTIN taxed here in 1649 who Dec 01, 1650 conveyed all his premises to WILLIAM FURBER.

Not a single AUSTIN appears on the list of Baptisms in the last century; the inference being that they were mostly Quakers. The AUSTIN interest in the sawmills ceased somewhere between 1719-1760.
