I am sorry for the delay in answering your first letter of August 12, 1966. I kept holding off thinking I would find more information for you as I have very little THOMAS AUSTIN lineage.

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The following is the family information of ISABELLA AUSTIN PRICE.. She was born 31 Jan 1781 in Maryland. She died 22 Nov 1852 and buried in Pattonville Community Cemetery, Jackson County, Ohio. She married RICHARD H. PRICE 19 Aug 1806 in Caroline County, Maryland. RICHARD was born 27 Feb 1781 in Maryland. He died 01 Dec 1857 and buried P.C.C. They had six children, three boys and three girls, as follows.

1. LYDIA. She was born 17 April 1807 in Maryland. She died Dec 1876 and buried P.C.C. She married DAVID KIRKENDALL. He was born 1806 in Penn. Died and buried I don't know where.

A brief break from the busy hustle and bustle of my Christmas job at Sears and the home duties that are always to be done to bring you up to date on my AUSTINS and to answer your last letter.

A new piece of evidence that has me excited and perhaps on the way to finding out who these AUSTINS really are. Last time I was at Iowa City I worked on more of the HIGGENS census and also went through the Ohio Cross roads for a HIGGENS searcher -Found a PAT WOOD who had the same family that I was interested in and on my arrival home told my sister about the gal, as she too is working on HIGGENS and that she had traced these same HIGGENS in her query to Iowa. Sis told me she thought she had an article on this same family that she had cut from the paper one time and to my delight it was the same family, so without delay I wrote to Mr. MAHLON HIGGENS of Webster, Iowa, and now have a reply from him. JOSEPH HIGGENS was his gr-grgrandfather and it is his niece PAT WOOD who has been doing the family genealogy. Now to tell you of their findings which he also helped her with. His grandfather WARREN HIGGENS came to Iowa in

1853, the same year GEORGE'S grandfather came to Iowa. Coincidence? I don't really think so as the next year his gr-grandfather MYRICH HIGGENS (who is one of those sons mentioned in JOSEPH HIGGENS's will 1832) came to Iowa and I found living in the same residence 1856 a HENRY AUSTIN who gave his time of residence in the state as 2 yrs the same as MYRICK - thus they must have come to Iowa at the same time.

MAHLON HIGGENS gives MYRICKS place of residency as Marion, Ohio, 1853 and 1854, so now I am anxious to work over those AUSTINS in Marion Co. I have these AUSTIN marriages from Marion Co. which I will insert here as this is all I have on it.

ALEXANDER AUSTIN - MATILDA MITCHELL, marr Mar 03, 1853 by J. BURGESS M. GOTFRIED
AUSTIN - CHRISTINE SNYDER marr mar 10, 1844 by G. SNYDER, J.P. OLIVER AUSTIN -AMELIA REDDING marr May 29, 1858, by JAMES KING, J.P. SYLVESTER AUSTIN - ELISABETH CULBERTSON marr Nov 25, 1850, by B. WALL M.

Note OLIVER AUSTIN here and DAVID mentioned a sister OLIVE in his letter. Could be related? Now this HENRY AUSTIN was born in Ohio and 35, so believe there may be a relationship here. But to go on with the letter from Jr. HIGGENS; he gives that his gr-gr grandfather JOSEPH HIGGENS 1st wife was POLLY RAND who bore 8 children and died 1804 and his 2nd wife was a HANNAH AUSTIN who bore 4 children (so it looks as if my theory that DAVID'S mother was a widow is now about to bear some fruit). I suspect that she and STEPHEN SMITH's wife were sisters? (the one who kept ISAIH [ISAIAH?])

AARON B HIGGENS b July 24, 1805, Vermont.
LUCY HIGGENS, April 22, 1808, Marietta, Ohio

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HANNAH was probably DAVID'S Mother and by this they were Vt. in 1804, then Ohio 1808-Knox Co., by 1812 thus proving that the JAMES and DAVID in the war of 1812 are probably our men and are brothers. 1814 HANNAH HIGGENS died and this is no doubt the reason that no mention of parents were made in the letter of DAVID's to ISAIH. Now JOSEPH remarried, the 3rd time to a SARAH CROSS, she died 1850 at the age of 80. It seems likely that JOSEPH HIGGENS is the only parent that DAVID probably knew so this is the reason he was mentioned.

Do you have any different ideas on this thing that I do? I hope I have presented them so that you can make out a reasonable story or drama.

My next correspondence or visit with them will, I hope, uncover more of the areas that these families resided - enabling us to eventually uncover the rest of the story.

Now, you have those mentioned in JOSEPH's will as well as those in this letter who are no doubt DAVID's 1/2 brothers and sister, so this spreads the possibilities to many directions along with those that are mentioned in the letter. I do believe I am coming close to some of the answers and this I hope will enable me to eventually find the family my husband's grand father is descended of.

You asked me in your last letter if 1860 census gave Va. or Md as DAVID's birthplace. No, it gave Ohio. Now that is a mistake I'm sure! I have never found a thing to indicate a double marriage for DAVID AUSTIN but who is to say I won't? Knox Co. marriage records do not reveal any DAVID AUSTIN marriages from 1827-1850.

Do you suppose that JOSEPH and HANNAH may have used the name of her deceased husband for one of the 4 children she bore? AARON-CHARLES-JESSE. You also asked as to what County JAMES AUSTIN was in, in Mo.?

Dear JANET:

A few lines to bring you up to date on my AUSTIN progress - perhaps you will be able to come up with some ideas or data from your files once I fill you in.

The will of JOSEPH HIGGENS established a relationship with DAVID AUSTIN and the latter information establishes step-son and father. I do not recall if I had written you that I had found HIGGENS descendants close to us and had written them. They had written and searched for HIGGENS materials and now have 2 genealogies on the HIGGENS family and the 3rd one in the making.

In their genealogy they relate that JOSEPH HIGGENS married (2nd) a HANNAH AUSTIN. Now I do not know if it was in Cornith, Vermont they were married, but assume so as the HIGGENS were living in Vermont 1787 when the 1st child JOSEPH Jr. was born to JOSEPH Sr and his 1st wife POLLY RAND who were married Feb. 14, 1786 in Chelsa[Chelsea], Mass. She bore 8 children and died in 1804 at Corinth. Now JOSEPH didn't lose any time marrying HANNAH AUSTIN as their 1st child was born July 24, 1805. So assume that HANNAH was already a widow - perhaps as early as 1800 when ISAIH[ISAIAH] was 2 years old and this may be the reason he was left with the SMITH family who do not necessarily mean that they were even related.

I think our AUSTINS are in the 1800 census but which one is a guess at any rate. I am still convinced that BENJAMINE was a brother to DAVID and that his census reveals that he was born in Vt. 1792. DAVID and JAMES b Md. 1790.

Now a strange twist - the HIGGENS have a little confusion on a man by the name of RAND HIGGENS who the relatives insist that he was a brother to JOSEPH Jrs., a son of DAVID and that they could not find him or where he went, they had only a marriage record that he was married Knox Co., Ohio to a SARAH HUMPHERYS. Jan 25, 1832. Well, I remembered I had records some where on a RAND HIGGENS and here he was in Shelby Co., Ill. with DAVID AUSTIN, 40 years old 1850, b in Ohio, and a Miller. The names of his children indicate he was of this same family sand the name of RAND is the maiden name of the 1st wife, but here is what is queer - RAND was b 1810 by the census which would have meant that HANNAH was his mother if he was of this family and would have been a 1/2 brother to DAVID AUSTIN - so I wonder if HANNAH May have been a sister to POLLY RAND and that is why the boy was named RAND. Had it been me naming a child I would not have used the maiden name of my husband's 1st wife unless it were in common. Any way, keep an eye out for a HANNAH RAND who married a AUSTIN. However, I feel that JOSEPH Jr. would have been old enough to have married by 1808 or 1809 and that this could be the son of JOSEPH Jr. who may have spent a lot of time in the home of the grandparents. He was not mentioned as a son in the Will of JOSEPH Sr., also they had never found his birth records with the rest of the family children on the old Bibles so looks like another puzzle for the HIGGENS to work out.

The 1/2 brothers and sister to DAVID were AARON B. HIGGENS born July 24 1805, Vt.; LUCY HIGGENS b April 22, 1808, Marietta, Ohio; CHARLES HIGGENS b April 20, 1810, Ohio, died 1810; JESSE HIGGENS, Feb 09, 1812, Knox Co., Ohio. So you can see the migration pattern in the dates of birth, also note that

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CHARLES HIGGENS b 1810 and RAND HIGGENS was b ca 1810., looks like an impossibility - right?

Am trying some new angles on the Shelby Co. AUSTINS to see if I can get some one interested in helping with the records there. I am hopeful.

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Have so many records and census that I would like to get copied to send your way, but seems that I am destined to keep working for a while anyway. The dept. I was working in has had quite a time finding help since the Dept. manager quit - then the regular full time girl took his place the full time girl under her became pregnant and so I became a partime regular, working 3 days a week but after the inventory is over I may only be working 2 days and will then have a day I can use otherwise also to go to Iowa City. Oh yes, to help keep me out of mischief, my close friend and Pres. of Linn County Heritage had a heart attack so as Vice Chairman, I have had to step up in her place and this month we have an all-day meeting. We are going to have lots of fun working on scrapbooks as we are cutting out historical articles from Linn Co. papers and making a scrap book of each paper.

Must close and get to bed as I have to work tomorrow morning then I am going up to my dad's place in Jones Co., and clean up his house and bake him up some goodies. He lives alone up there since my mother passed away last year and so we try to do up his laundry and cleaning about twice a month, some times 3 times.

Winter has arrived in full bluster and we have about 8" of snow. Suppose you have plenty there as well. Hoping to hear from you,
